#### Venue

#### Lessons held at Encore Studios – held at 104A William Street, Bathurst.

Scots All Saints' College Lessons - to be held at school on site for SASC students only. Teachers collect the children from class and take them back at the completion of their lesson.

For students having recess and lunch classes, they can bring their food to eat in class.

Parents are asked to drop off their children just inside

the door at the bottom of the stairs and wait for collection outside the front entrance door. Teachers will bring children to the entrance door at the completion of their lesson. If their parents are not there to collect they can wait inside in the small waiting area at the bottom of the stairs for safety.

#### Parents do not sit in on lessons as this can cause disruption and children seem to work best with their peers without parents.

#### What to bring?

#### **Speech and Drama**

The studio will provide students with **an A4 display folder AND exercise book each week for their work**. Teachers write feedback in the exercise books each week for you to read. This is a good communication tool for parents and teachers as teachers do not have time at the end of each class to discuss due to commencing the next class. *Current students: please remember to bring the pieces you were using from Term 4/previous year with your current new work in it at start of yr.* 



#### **Creative Writing/Tutoring**

The studio will provide a workbook and appropriate textbook for all students.

#### Drop off and pick up

Please refer to earlier part of newsletter for drop off and pick up requirements. Parents are asked to wait at the front door entrance for all lessons. If a child arrives early for a lesson they may sit on the seat inside the door to wait before their lesson begins. For safety, only students are allowed up the stairs in studios as access is strictly monitored by teachers.

#### **Enrolment**

Policy forms can be printed and sent with your child completed to the first lesson. Please do not email the enrolment forms back. Originals will also be distributed Week 1 for parents to sign and return in Week 2. This is to ensure we have correct spelling and date of birth records for your child.





As per our policy statement, please note that a child is enrolled for the full term. We require 3 weeks' notice if not returning for the following term otherwise fees will apply for cancellation. <u>A</u> student will not be able to attend lessons until full payment of term is made up front.

#### SERVICE NSW CREATIVE KIDS \$100 VOUCHER

Encore is now a registered provider for the Service NSW Creative Kids \$100 voucher. This means you can apply on the Service NSW website and get a \$100 voucher per year for each school aged children (aged 4.5 years and up) to put towards our Encore fees. Please send your voucher to me ASAP if you haven't done already. This is a great new initiative and we are glad to be able to offer this to all of our parents and students.

#### FEES

All fees are payable by the commencement of the term. A child will not be able to attend classes unless payment for the term has been made to avoid chasing fees all term. We appreciate your assistance with this. A \$25 late fee will be added to your account if payment is made any later than date payable on the invoice.

# All classes are paid for even if missed, as the class still runs as scheduled.

## NO Makeup lessons are available if a class is missed.

Preferred method of payment is direct deposit or bank transfer, however cash and cheque is also acceptable. Payment details will be shown on the bottom of the invoice.

A \$20 annual enrolment form will be included for all students on first invoice and a \$10 administration fee is added onto each term invoice. The Fee Schedule is as per our current policy statement form which accompanies this pack. All fees are subject to GST.

# The studio now works on term allotments of average 8-9 weeks over the four terms.

*Term fees will now be a flat fee based on these averages for ALL students.* 









#### **Eisteddfods and IMEB Exams**

Children will get the opportunity to participate in the Bathurst Eisteddfod (held in September) and the IMEB Examination (October) as well as other Eisteddfods if they wish. Information is sent out about these closer to each event.

## **COVID-19 Regulations**

Thank you for your ongoing patience with keeping all of our students safe within the studio. Please note we will continue the following regulations until further notice:

\*NO Parents to enter the studio premises or studio entrances. Please ensure ONLY students come to the studio and parents wait in the car or at their car for pickup and drop off. This is very important to keep the community safe. Teachers can be contacted via phone or email outside of lesson hours ONLY for any questions or communication.
